Comments

Warm weather of the past few weeks continues to soften, consolidate and melt trails in this region. Spring skiing is in effect, with glazed or icy trails in the early morning, and softer wet snow in the afternoon. Grooming has ended for the season however, skiing is still possible, especially on higher elevation trails like Upper Skogan Pass, Skogan Loop, Sunburst and High Level. Expect to break trail or ski in skier-set track as any previous grooming or tracksetting has melted out.
